Challenge 1 - Inspector Europe

You could transform in Inspector Europe and study the countries that make up Europe.

This could involve: identifying the different flags, looking at populations and languages, studying the geography of Europe and the individual countries, producing fact files around particular countries, finding out about local customs, traditional foods and activities.

You can present your findings in whatever way you choose.

You could create a tourist information brochure for London.

This could include looking at a map of London, writing and drawing about famous landmarks and attractions, how to travel there. Try to make London as attractive as possible, to encourage plenty of tourists to come and visit.

You could design and make a chair fit for a Prime Minister. Find out about the role of the Prime Minister, draw and label a chair design, explain why it is suitable for a Prime Minister and what materials could you use to create it?

Try to make the chair as near to your design plan as you can.
